Personalized ornaments were given and there were over 210 people in attendance. Because each person's grief journey is unique, many bereaved grandparents find they are grieving much differently than their spouse and other family members. Grief can affect the family dynamic, as everyone processes their grief at different speeds and in different ways. Each grandparent had their own relationship with their grandchild and will likely have their own way of grieving as well, which may create added stress within the family relationships. There is no right or wrong way to grieve and there are no time tables. Communication, understanding and patience with one another are critical while on the grief journey.
