PARENTS CORNER

We want to have this spot to address things that are on your minds. A place to perhaps share something you have found helpful on your journey, an encouragement for others, thank you Disney's mom, Donna Pfeiffer for sharing this with us.

After leaving the hospital with my daughter's belongings it wasn't until days later I discovered she had kept a journal of her feelings for the past several years. I felt her pain as I read how she was suffering both mentally and physically. I would wake in the middle of the night and read it over and over. Then I started writing in her journal. My letter to her always began "Dear Disney" and ended "Love Mom". It's been nine years now and I am not writing as often. The pain is still there but not as unbearable as it was in the beginning.

Her Journal turned out to be my therapy.

Donations & Foundations

In our Candle Lighting invitation we asked to be made aware of foundations that our families have created in honor of their loved ones. Please take a look at the amazing things these families have done. I received information from :

FOUNDATIONS: The Jonathan Yurewitch Memorial Fund Proceeds will be divided among causes Jonathan believed in. At the time of his death, Jonathan was volunteering for the Daniel Pitino Homeless Shelter in Owensboro, KY. My husband & I visited the shelter when we traveled to KY to retrieve Jonathan's belongings. Jonathan passed from epilepsy, so funds have been earmarked for the research and cure of epilepsy/SUDEP (Sudden Unexpected Death in Epilepsy.)

Ethan and Lily Foundation supplies book vouchers for underprivileged children for the annual bookfair at Village Oaks Elementary and maintains the two butterfly gardens on school grounds. At the Vineyards Elementary we supply monetary awards given at the 5th grade recognition ceremony as well as maintain the butterfly garden at that school.

Butterflies of Hope was created to carry on the memory of Rylee Andersen. It now is also to carry on the memory of Rylee's brother Xavier as well.

We raise money to help other families fight the deadly disease that took our children from us way too soon. Currently we have joined forces with another family that is affected by Mitochondrial Disease to raise 1 Million Dollars for the UMDF to help find a cure. The million dollar mission is being spear headed by our two amazing 11 year old children. For more info please visit www.butterfliesofhope.com Our motto is Hope, Strength, Courage

The Mighty Mikey Foundation was founded in memory of Michael Weinstein and his love of puppets. We will be creating a Mighty Mikey Puppet to bring into children's hospitals. These puppets will be used to offer comfort, education, and Hope for whatever disease or illness these children maybe battling. During Michaels many trips to Sloan for treatment of his Brain Tumor, child life was an integral part of his comfort. He now will be comforting many in his own way.
